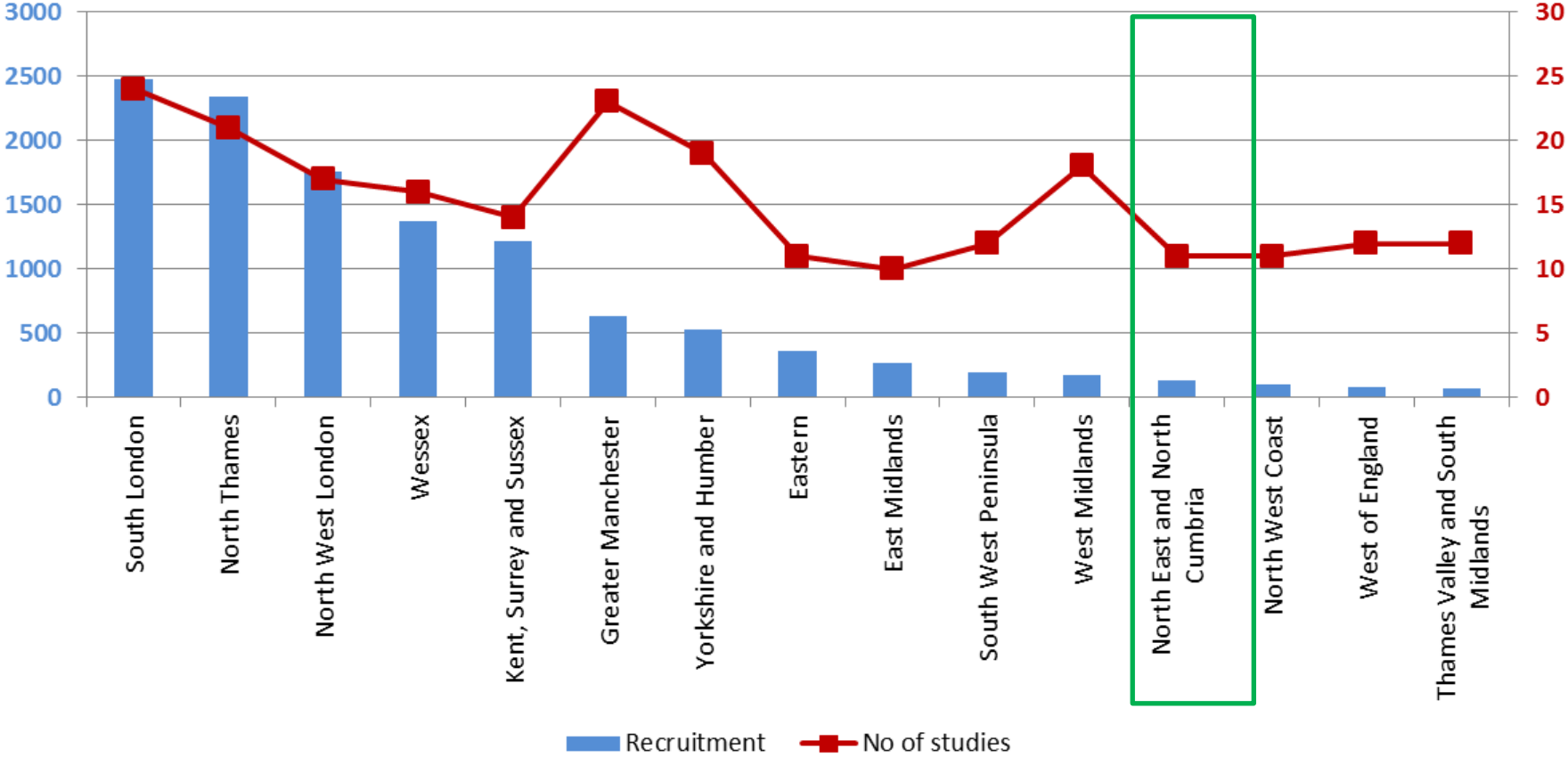

2018/19 Recruitment per LCRN (as at 26/10/18)

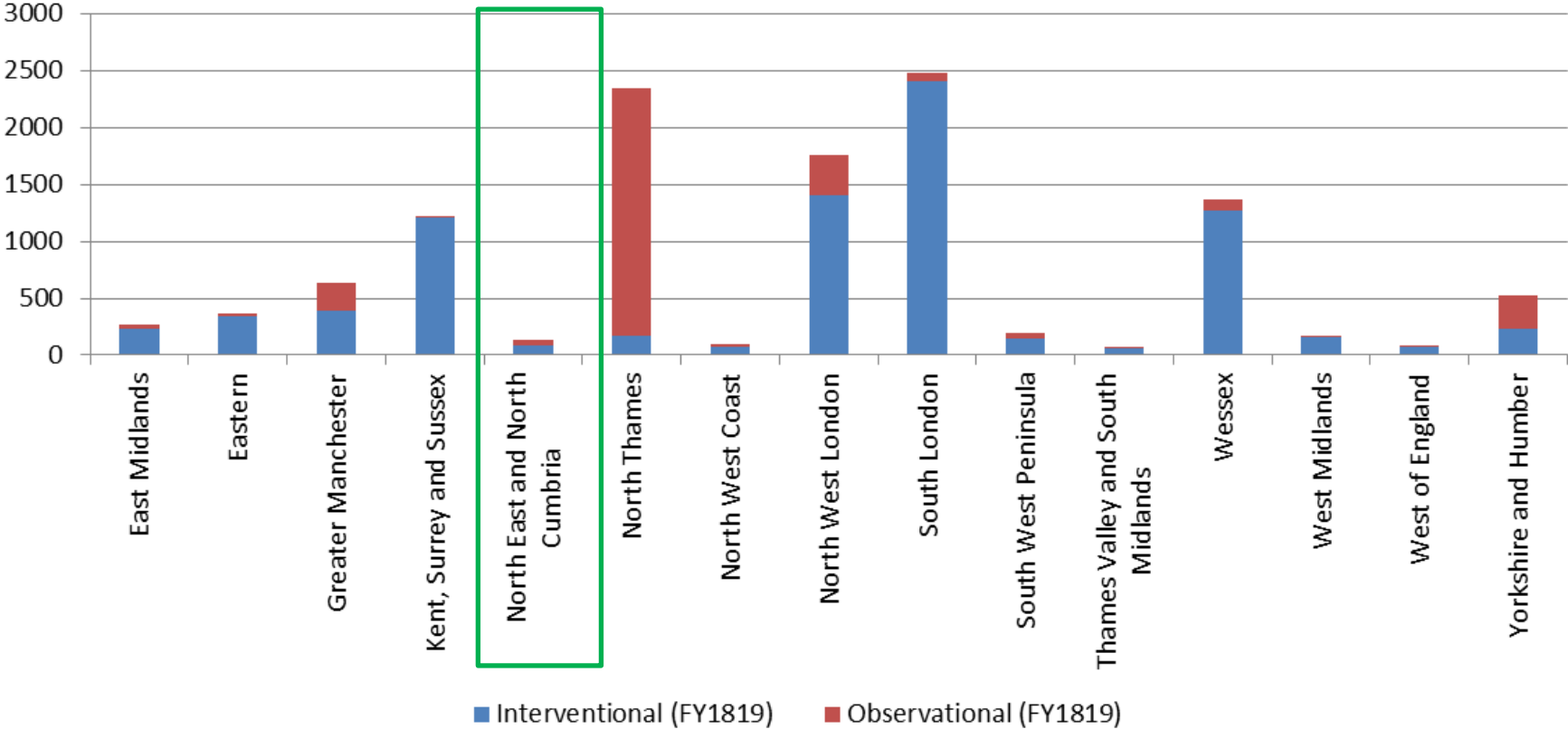

2018/19 Recruitment per LCRN - interventional/observational (as at 26/10/18)

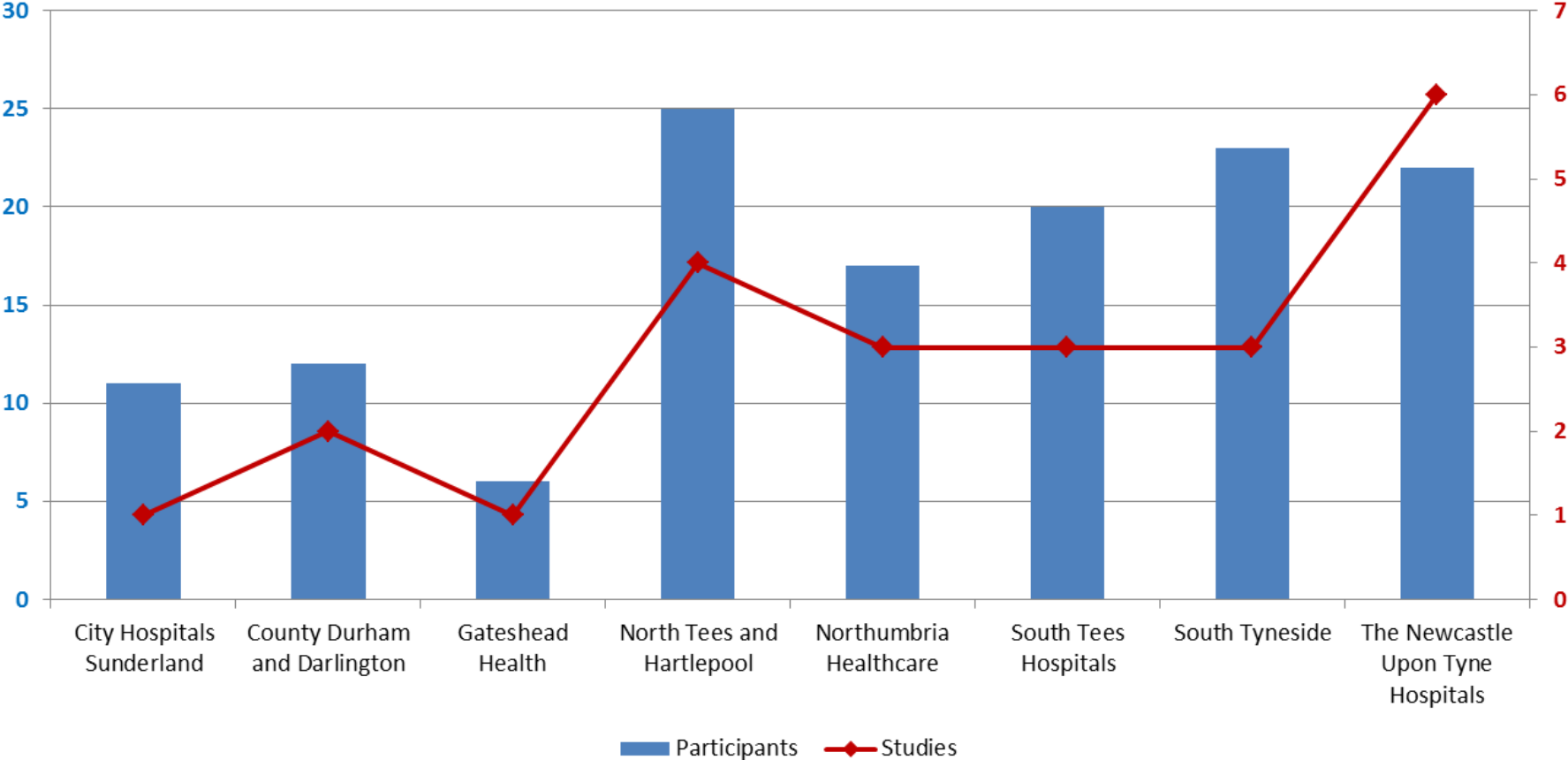
