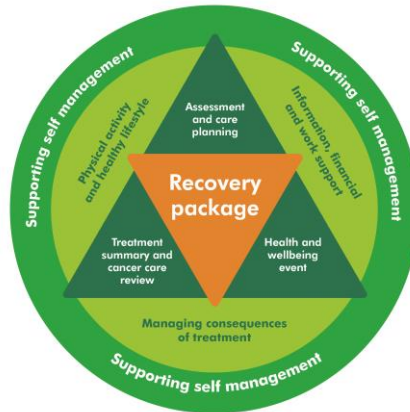

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What is the Macmillan Recovery Package?



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- Package of care to support people who are living with and beyond cancer to receive the best care we can provide.
- National roll out of all elements of the Recovery Package by 2020.
- Lots of information out there to support people but not as much in easy read format.
- As part of the Humber Coast and Vale Cancer Alliance Living With and Beyond cancer programme, a cancer care review pack was put together and this included easy read resources.
