Cancer causes more than one in four of all deaths, 2016, UK

Common cancers



Almost half of all cancer deaths are lung, bowel, breast or prostate cancer, 2016, UK



More than half of new cases of cancer are breast, prostate, lung or bowel cancer, 2015, UK

About **1.5 Million** people in the UK have a Learning disability

People with a learning disability are **2.5 times** more likely to have a health problem

People with learning disabilities die **13 -20** years younger than other people

People with a learning disability and cervical screening 2016-17 **30% v 75%** learning disability compared to women with no learning disability
