Holistic Needs Assessment (HNA)

This is completed by secondary care colleagues (typically a Clinical Nurse Specialist) at certain points in a patient's cancer journey. This is usually completed around the time of diagnosis and at when a patient finishes treatment (dependent on patient need though). The patient answers a questionnaire, this leads to a conversation to discuss the answers and then a care plan is created together. This is electronically transferred over to primary care to assist conversations at the Cancer Care Review.

End of Treatment summary (EOTS)

This is a template which is completed by secondary care outlining an overview of the patient's diagnosis, treatment and outcome. It has a dedicated section identifying next steps for primary care. A copy of this is sent to both patients and primary care.

Cancer Care Reviews (CCRs)

These are completed by primary care colleagues (typically GPs or Practice Nurses) and occur at set points throughout the pathway (as per QOF guidance). We have an enhanced service specification in Thames Valley which practices can sign up to and deliver a second CCR to patients during their first year of diagnosis.
